HOW TO MAKE A BIBLE BOOKMARK

SUPPLIES:

- Cardstock
- Scissors
- Measuring Tape
- Ribbon (various colors)
- Glue sticks
- Cutting board (optional)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut 15-inch sections of ribbon – at least 4 ribbons for every woman. We cut extra ribbons in a variety of colors so they could pick and choose.
2. If making for a large group, place the ribbons inside a zippered bag for each table. (We had 8 women at each table and 8 of each color of ribbon. There were 10 colors total per bag.)
3. If desired, place your logo or theme on the bookmarks before printing. (This can be done easily in Canva. You could also put a sticker on the bookmarks.)
4. Use a cutting board and pair of scissors to cut out the bookmarks. Cut only on the solid line. The dotted line is for folding.
5. Before assembling the bookmark, cut it down to size based on the spine of your Bible.
6. Fold the bookmark on the dotted line and apply glue to the inside of the bookmark. Place your 4 ribbons side-by-side on top of the glue. Add some more glue on top of the ribbons. Fold the cardstock over and press down.
7. Slide the bookmark into the spine of the Bible and trim the ribbons. You can keep the ribbon from fraying by using Stop Fraying (on my [Amazon list here](#)).

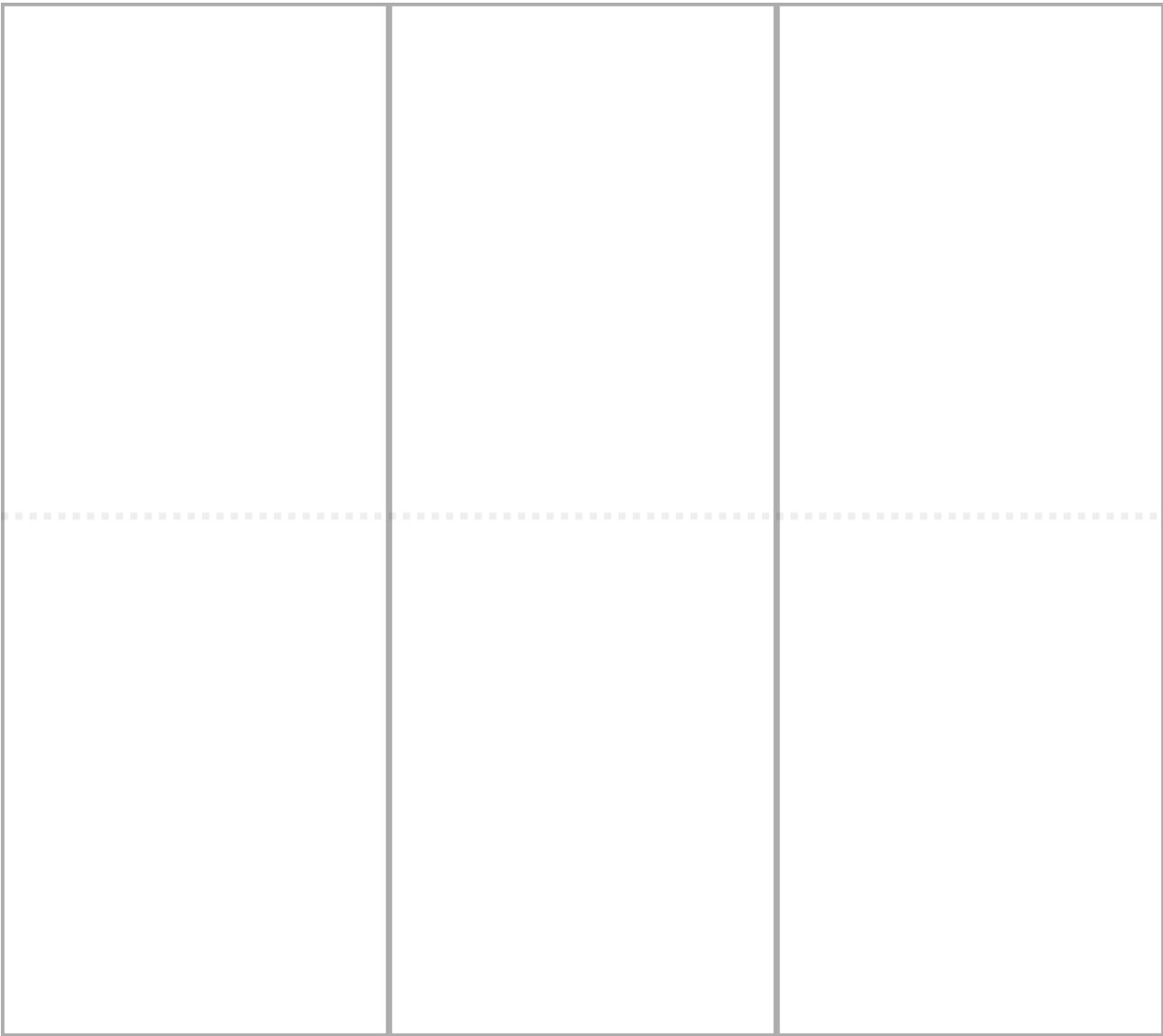
NOTE:

If you're doing this with a group, you'll want to have:

- One cardstock bookmark per person
- A minimum of four ribbons per person
- 2-3 glue sticks in each bag
- 1-2 pair of scissors in each bag

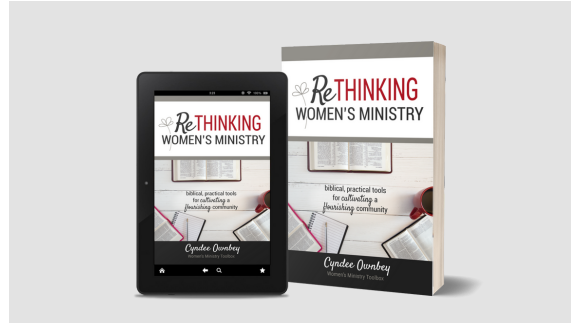
